Valid for the following CF sites: Gernsbach, Ober-Schmitten, Dresden, Scaer, Lydney, Caerphilly, Newtech

Note 1: In general, Glatfelter CF has implemented a Due Diligence System for its complete procured wood fibre based materials, which comply with the requirements of the EUTR as well as with the FSC Controlled Wood requirements.

Note 2: Glatfelter CF is an "operator" for pulp that are purchased from outside EU and brought to the European market for the first time.

Note 3: Glatfelter CF is a "trader" for pulp and papers that are purchased from inside EU.
