

ASSEMBLY AND USEAGE INDICATIONS FOR MOVELAR BRICK BARBECUES

FOR A CORRECT, ENDURABLE USEAGE OF MOVELAR BARBECUES, PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY.

WE WOULD LIKE TO REMIND YOU THAT THE INSTALLATION OF A BARBECUE REQUIRES A CERTAIN TECHNICAL KNOWLEDGE OF THE ASSEMBLY METHODS.

THIS IS WHY WE WOULD RECOMMEND THAT YOU CONTRACT SUITABLE INSTALLERS TO ASSEMBLE YOUR BARBECUES. FOR PROPER ASSEMBLY, YOU SHOULD BEAR IN MIND THE FOLLOWING RECOMMENDATIONS:

BEFORE COMMENCING ASSEMBLY:

- THE PARTS ARE USUALLY MADE OF CONCRETE/BRICK AND THEY ARE THUS PARTICULARLY SENSITIVE TO BLOWS AND VIBRATIONS DURING TRANSPORT AND ASSEMBLY.
- THE BARBECUE SHALL REST UPON A FLAT, RIGID AND LEVELLED FLOOR.
- IT SHALL BE INSTALLED IN SUCH A WAY THAT ALLOWS THE SPECIFIC SWELLING/CONTRACTION OF THIS TYPE OF PRODUCTS, OTHERWISE THERE MAY BE CRACKS. TO THIS END, IT SHOULD NOT BE STUCK TO A WALL, LEAVING CLEARANCE OF AROUND 5 CM. THE CANOPY SHALL BE BASED ON THE BARBECUE BUT NOT STUCK TO IT.
- THE PRODUCT WE USE TO PUT TOGETHER THE VARIOUS PARTS VARIES IN LINE WITH THE MODEL, ASK THE VENDORS FOR INFORMATION AT THE STORE WHERE YOU BOUGHT THE BARBECUE.
- BEFORE PERMANENTLY AFFIXING THE SIDE PARTS OF THE FIRE AREA WITH A REFRACTORY MORTAR, YOU SHOULD ADJUST THE GRILL IN SUCH A WAY THAT IT MOVES HORIZONTALLY IN ITS GROOVES WITHOUT DIFFICULTY.

MAKING IT WORK:

- **AFTER ASSEMBLY, THE BARBECUE SHALL BE DRIED THOROUGHLY BEFORE USING IT.**
- THE FIRST TIME YOU LIGHT THE BARBECUE, THIS SHALL BE DONE WITH CHARCOAL, HEATING THE EMBERS THEN MAKING THEM GROW GRADUALLY FOR THREE OF FOUR HOURS. WHEN FIRST USED, AVOID VERY STRONG FLAMES, AS THE CONCRETE AND BRICK NEED TO PROGRESSIVELY ADAPT TO THE CONDITIONS IN WHICH THEY ARE TO BE USED. TO THIS END, THE ADAPTATION SHALL BE CARRIED OUT DURING THE INITIAL USAGES, BURNING FIREWOOD WITH A LOW HEAT POTENTIAL. THE RESISTANCE OF YOUR BARBECUE SHALL DEPEND ON THE INITIAL USAGES.
REMEMBER THAT THE MAIN AIM WITH THE SUBSEQUENT COMBUSTION OF FIREWOOD (AFTER THE INITIAL USES) IS THE PRODUCTION OF THE NUMBER OF EMBERS REQUIRED TO COOK THE FOOD.
IF YOU PUT IN TOO MUCH FIREWOOD WITH RAPID INITIAL COMBUSTION, THIS SHALL RESULT IN EXCESSIVE HEATING OF THE BARBECUE AND A WASTE OF HEAT AND FIREWOOD. ADD THE FIREWOOD GRADUALLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH COOKING NEEDS.
- SHOULD YOUR BARBECUE BE ASSEMBLED IN AN OPEN OR VERY HUMID PLACE, CHECK THAT THE FIRE AND CANOPY AREA IS DRY BEFORE USING IT. **IF IT IS WET, DON'T USE IT.**
IF IT IS WET, START OFF BY DRYING IT WITH A VERY LOW LIGHT, THEN USING IN REGULAR FASHION (WHEN DRY).
- AFTER USING THE BARBECUE, YOU CAN REMOVE THE FIREWOOD CHARCOAL WHICH HAS BEEN PRODUCED AND WHICH HAS NOT BEEN CONSUMED YET FOR SUBSEQUENT USEAGE. REMOVE THE ASHES, BUT **DO NOT WASH THE BARBECUE UNTIL IT IS TOTALLY COOL.**
UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES MAY WATER BE PUT ON TO COOL OR WASH THE BARBECUE. THE BARBECUE MAY ONLY BE WETTENED WHEN IT IS TOTALLY COOL (SUDDEN CHANGES IN TEMPERATURE MAY CAUSE CRACKS OR THE RUPTURE OF THE CONCRETE AND THE BRICK).

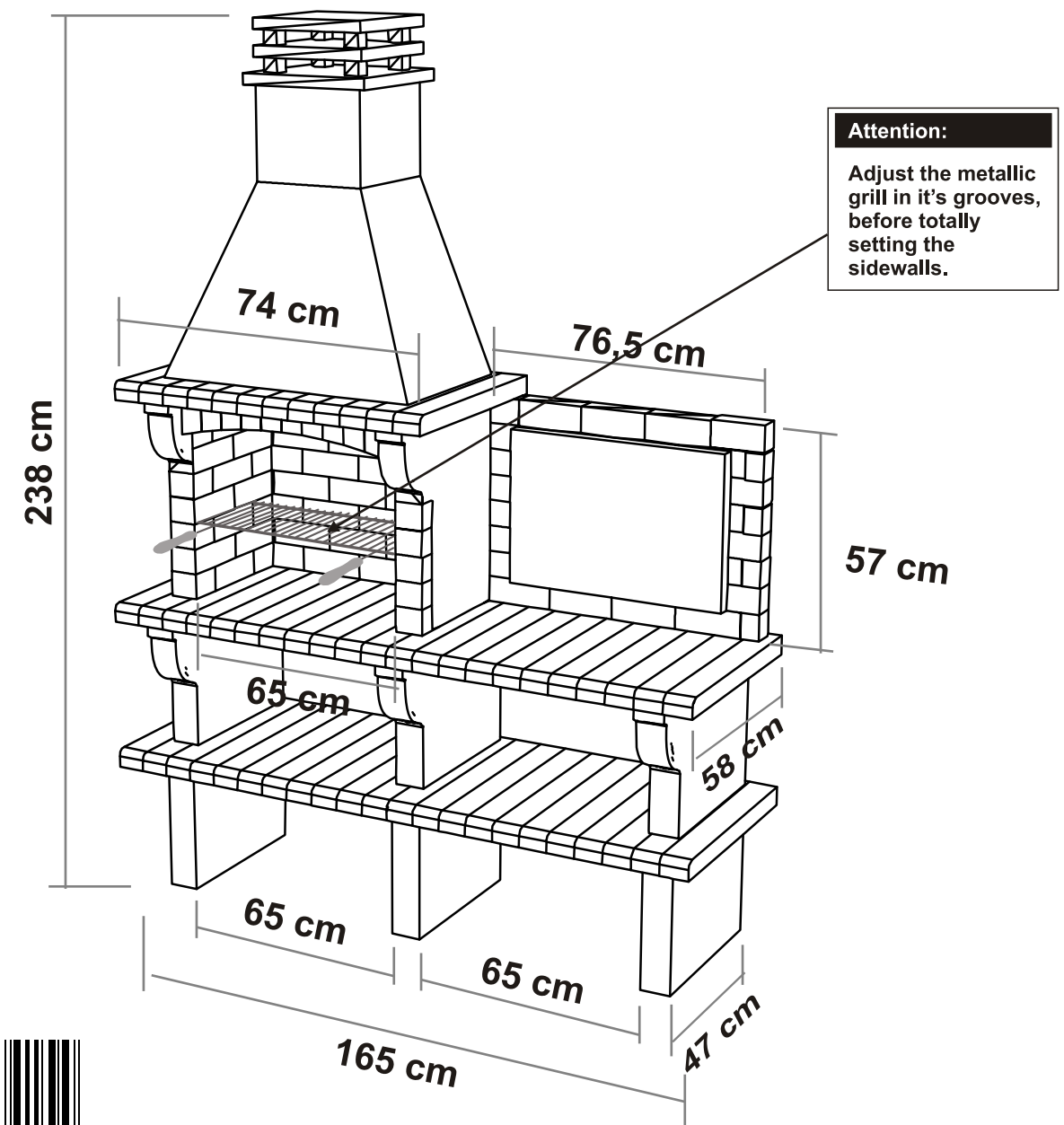
SHOULD YOU HAVE ANY DOUBTS, PLEASE CONSULT THE VENDORS AT THE STORE WHERE YOU ACQUIRED THE BARBECUE.

WE WOULD ALSO RECOMMEND YOU TO USE SUITABLE TRANSPORT (ALWAYS PALLETISED), AS, BY DINT OF THE CHARACTERISTICS OF THE MATERIAL THE LATTER MAY BREAK WITH THE VIBRATIONS SUFFERED WHEN NOT PROPERLY TRANSPORTED.
