RE: NEW EUROPEAN BATTERY REGULATION

Dear Customer,

The European Union has adopted new laws regarding all forms of batteries, including portable batteries of general use. The European Battery Regulation (which replaces the European Battery Directive – 2006/66/EC) comes into effect on 17 August 2023, updates EU law and introduces several new concepts, such as supply chain due diligence, performance standards, and restrictions of certain metals.

We at Energizer have been engaged in the legislative process since it began in 2019 and will remain engaged through the remaining administrative processes. We are knowledgeable of the content of the Regulation and confident that all Energizer products will meet applicable requirements within the periods of time set forth in the regulation.

With respect to any obligations that take effect immediately or within several months of the law coming into effect, such as the identification of specific metals and new extended producer responsibility levels, Energizer is already compliant. Since obtaining the certainty that the Regulation is final and will not be amended, we are following a path to compliance on each topic potentially requiring a change and are confident all future requirements applicable to portable batteries of general use will be met in a timely manner.
